Hence, $\rightarrow I$ is the niece of K .

[A] West

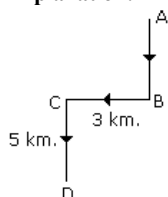

In the evening sun sets in West. Hence then any shadow falls in the East. Since Hema's shadow was to the right of Hema. Hence Rekha was facing towards South.

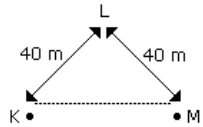
